The capital improvement project will provide a permanent solution to this park's sanitary, potable water, and reclaimed water facilities and provide improved protection of the water quality in the Green Swamp Area of Critical State Concern.

The intent of this park project is to design, build, and connect a wastewater, potable water, and reclaimed water system inside the 141 acre South Lake Regional Park to the City of Groveland's existing Central Wastewater, Potable Water and Reclaimed Water Systems.

The project will provide a permanent solution to this park's sanitary, potable water, and reclaimed water facilities and provide improved protection of the water quality in the Green Swamp Area of Critical State Concern.
