Lincoln Street, between N. 36th Ave and N. 40th Ave, is an area without sanitary sewer services that is in close proximity to existing sewer service lines. City plans to complete the design and permitting of the new sanitary gravity sewer system with in house staff. The project could be bid for construction before September 2019.

11. Program Performance:

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

The City will install sewer pipe in the various sizes(8” and 12”), sewer manholes, 6” sewer lateral and cleanout at each residence the along N 40th Ave, Farragut St, N 38th Ave, N 36th Ave, Atlanta St and Simms St. After the sewer system is completed, the City will repave the affected roads.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The City staff will design, permit, bid and manage the construction of the project.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

After the sewer collection system has been installed and after all residences have been connected to it via laterals, the septic tanks for the connected properties within the referenced service area will be abandoned. All sewer from these properties will be collected to Southern Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant for treatment. These improvements should reduce TMDL in this area.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Total 61 properties will be converted from septic to sewer under the project. Approximate 240 people are expected to be served by the new sewer system.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The effluent of septic tanks has a relatively high levels of nutrients due to ineffective treatment and fecal coliform. Prior to construction of the proposed system, proposed materials and methods will be reviewed for compliance with applicable Federal, State, County and City standards. During construction, the City will conduct tests and inspections during all phases of construction to ensure that the project is being constructed with the approved materials and methods. The City will also conduct additional inspections and surveys to verify that all the properties within the service area have been connected to the new sanitary sewer system and that all of the septic tanks have been abandoned. Prior to the City’s acceptance of the new sanitary sewer system, the City will review “asbuilts” of the system to verify that they system was indeed constructed in conformance with the approved design.
