1. Title of Project: Palmetto Roadway and Drainage Improvements

4. Project/Program Description:

This funding request is to cooperatively fund the complete reconstruction of the northern limits of Palmetto Road. The Town of Belleair is requesting assistance to reconstruct this failed roadway as further deferred maintenance is no longer an option. This includes the removal of all compromised infrastructure, from the sub-base of the road to the top asphalt layer and drainage routes. By reconstructing Palmetto Road, the town would improve transportation conditions drastically by reducing the amount of flooding, as well as producing a stable road that has not been degraded. Additionally, the Clearwater Harbor, an outstanding Florida water body, would be improved, as this project would reduce the amount of pollutants and contaminants that would be able to reach the body.

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project will improve transportation conditions by completely reconstructing the roadway, creating specific immediate job opportunities, improving stormwater management, and improving surface water quality.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Complete roadway reconstruction, including removal of all current existing roadway components, and improvements to the drainage system along Palmetto Road which outfalls into Clearwater Harbor, which is an outstanding Florida water body.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

By renovating the road, transportation conditions will improve as well as stormwater management and surface water quality. This project will also create immediate job opportunities.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will directly impact the residents of the Town of Belleair, which has approximately 4,000 residents. This project will also affect the surrounding population that travels through Belleair.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will improve transportation conditions and stormwater management by decreasing the amount of flooding and degradation of roadways. This will be measured by public outreach and forums, traffic and flood monitoring, and a comparative before and after analyses. Surface water quality will also improve due to the reconstructed roadway that would convey surface water into newly installed and updated portions of storm



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drainage collection. Economic improvement will be monitored by the number of individuals hired to work on the project.
