- a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?
  - This is a Moss property rehydration project that may have some minor secondary flood protection benefits to ITID's M-1 Basin.
- b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

  Installation of a 50 cfs pump that has the intake in ITID's M-1 Impoundment and discharges into the FFWCC's Moss property. Monitoring equipment is also required by the permit on the Moss property.
- c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?
  - The Moss property will be partially rehydrated and benefit the hydroperiod of the area with some wetlands enhancement gaming opportunities as regulated by the FFWCC.

  - The visitors of the property are estimated to be less than 1000/year. There are some minor potential flood control benefits to the 38,000 ITID residents. (Thomas: these numbers are off the top of my head)

  - Adds water to the Moss property that is underhydrated. Stage and water quality monitoring are required within the Moss property in the FDEP permit.
