a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

The requested funds will be used for environmental studies, site design, engineering, permitting, construction and mitigation required for a project to preserve, improve and enhance the environment, water quality and recreational access to Shell Key Preserve in southern Pinellas County. Specifically, the funds will be used for a project to connect two small craft navigational channels, which in turn will provide fill for a dredge hole in the preserve and allow for seagrass and habitat restoration.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funds will be spent on environmental assessments, engineering, design and permitting, excavation/dredging, construction, seagrass restoration, and program management.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Enhanced recreational and commercial access to the project area and to areas beyond the project area that are currently being restricted as a result of decreasing water depth, through which larger vessels can no longer pass.

- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
 - The target population is residents and visitors of Pinellas County, including boating, diving and recreational users of marine resources in the project area. An estimate of how many individuals will be served is unknown.
- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Enhanced, improved and preserved marine environmental resources, including fish and other marine wildlife, and habitat improvements; improved surface water quality; improved water flow and flushing; and enhanced boating access for both recreational and commercial activities. The outcome will be measured by monitoring and surveying.
