Expansion of a Regional Stormwater Pond and Recreational Park with Florida Trailhead in the City of Oviedo's Historic Downtown. This project is designed to provide flood attenuation, surface water quality improvement, partial restoration of Sweetwater Creek, public recreation space and economic growth through redevelopment. The current pond is in the Lake Jesup drainage basin and Saint Johns River Water Management District. The project will help meet the St. Johns River TMDL and BMAP requirements.

The funds will allow construction of the Regional Stormwater Pond and Recreational Park with Trailhead in the City of Oviedo's Downtown.

This project is designed to provide flood attenuation, surface water quality improvement, partial restoration of Sweetwater Creek, public recreation space and economic growth through redevelopment.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

The Master Stormwater Pond will help the City of Oviedo SJRWMD TMDL and BMAP requirements thereby improving surface water quality in the Lake Jesup Basin. Improved surface water quality and recreational use of the Park/Trailhead will have a direct impact to physical health.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Citizens of the City of Oviedo and State of Florida.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The Oviedo Master Stormwater project will provide flood attenuation and this will be measured by the prevention of localized flooding. The project will also help meet the St. Johns River TMDL and BMAP requirements and will be determined by lab sampling of nitrogen and phosphorus. Additionally the project will allow for remove on site stormwater ponds increasing the land base for redevelopment projects. This will be measured by the completion of proposed redevelopment of the adjacent parcels. Lastly, the project will allow for increased usage of outdoor recreation space. Which will be measured by the number of individuals coming to the park.
