a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

Funds would support the construction of road, water, sewer, and gas infrastructure to create new business development opportunities and connect existing industrial development parcels. Approximately 1.5 miles of infrastructure would be built connecting Randy Brown Road to Jeff Ates Road creating an alternative route for tenants to enter and leave the Santa Rosa Industrial Park and facilitating the development of an approximately 100+ acre manufacturing/assembly industrial park expansion.

- b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
 - The access road will provide an emergency access to existing companies located in the Santa Rosa Industrial Park and create access to additional parcels for commercial development and economic prosperity.

 - The road connector project would provide an alternative route into the industrial park and create further opportunities for economic development in the area.
