a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

To build a multimodal station as a regional park and ride for county transit services. b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Proposed park & ride facility supports the county's transit system for S. Dade residents from Homestead to Palmetto Bay, and also supports the village's efforts to reduce traffic congestion and commute times.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Access to transit, traffic reduction, and shorter commuting time in the heavily congested Miami-Dade County.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Our target population: elderly persons, jobless persons, economically disadvantaged persons, homeless, high school students, University/college students, and the general public. We expect greater than 800 people will be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

We expect to help protect the general public from harm, by enabling less carbon dioxide emissions to be expelled by reducing the number of cars in circulation. We expect to improve transportation conditions by providing shorter commutes from Homestead to downtown Miami. We expect to increase or improve economic activity, increase tourism, create specific immediate job opportunities, and enhance specific individuals economic self-sufficiency. Increased access to jobs will bring more businesses and tourism opportunities.

Withholding of state funds; inability to reach acceptable traffic LOS.
