A permanent power generator is needed at the city's only large, storm-hardened community center to serve as an alternate staging location for police or emergency staff. Police headquarters at 3250 Hollywood Boulevard does have a generator that can support the entire building but the building is not rated to withstand a Category 2 or higher hurricane. Also, a generator at the hardened community center will allow the city to provide critical support services to the public following a disaster.
