The requested funds will help to extend the useful life of the Franklin County landfill and allow the storm debris from Hurricane Michael and any future events to be efficiently processed.

Acquisition of additional acreage surrounding the current landfill and purchase of a tub grinder.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Hurricane debris will be processed quickly and more efficiently with the new tub grinder. With additional acreage, the landfill will be able to accept more debris from future events.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All citizens and visitors of Franklin County will benefit from this request, as having a landfill with adequate space and equipment will enable faster clean-up and restoration from future storm events.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The additional acreage will add years of useful life to the landfill and this benefit will be evident on the cost closure estimates/useful life calculations done by DEP. Storm debris will be processed more quickly after hurricane events.

Landfill activities and requirements are closely monitored by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.
