	a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?
	Funds will augment local plans to harden the South Florida Regional Emergency Shelter & Continuing Operations Center to enhanced standards, emergency power, and extended stay capabilities.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	Regional emergency and storm evacuation sheltering for southeastern coastal and central/southern Gulf coastal counties.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Easily-reachable, regional shelter space along the I-75 corridor, outside of evacuation zones on either coast of Florida.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	The general population of evacuated counties in central/southern Florida.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	Regional emergency sheltering to address the severe SWFL spatial deficit and reduce congestion on major evacuation routes - All measured by decreased traffic flow, fuel consumption, and increased shelter registration during an emergency or storm event.
f.	What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?
	\$1,000/day in liquidated damages for each day the facility fails to meet contractual obligations.
