The city is requesting funding for a bicycle-pedestrian shared use path that will run along the east side of Alton Road (SR 907) on Miami Beach. It will consist of buffered bi-directional bicycle lanes and a walking path on the east side of the road. The roadway has a high vehicular volume and this project will encourage a mode shift and decrease vehicular volume, resulting in increased safety for cyclists and pedestrians. The path is located further east of the roadway and will improve safety. Public transportation will be improved as there are bus stops along the road.

It is important to note that traffic crash incidence in Miami Beach are high and on the rise, with 6% more crashes in 2018 as compared with 2017, thus providing evidence of the project's importance.

Construction of a bicycle pedestrian path along State Road 907 (Alton Road).
