#### 11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Gainesville Opportunity Center (GOC) will acquire property and a building, and renovate and furnish the building as needed to provide services to those with persistent mental illness. The GOC is a member of Clubhouse International, providing recovery through work, delivering education, housing, employment, and social support.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Educational, social, employment, and housing support for those with persistent mental illness.

#### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The GOC provides a work ordered day in accord with Clubhouse International standards. Those with persistent mental illness participate in a structured day leading to transitional, supported, and independent employment.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population of this project is persons with persistent mental illness, including those with criminal justice involvement, who need assistance in obtaining stability, re-entering the community, and obtaining increased income or employment. Once a person becomes a "member" they are considered life time members and encouraged to be active on some level with the Gainesville Opportunity Center even after obtaining employment and wellness. Those who have been members longer then take on greater roles in the work centered day and encourage the new members to achieve stability and wellness.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit of the Gainesville Opportunity Center will be: increased stability for those with a mental illness to include fewer hospitalizations, more positive involvement with the community, decreased contact with law enforcement and the criminal justice system, increased income for those who qualify, transitional employment, supportive employment, independent employment, and increased partnerships with the local agencies and communities.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

Allocated funds should be recovered.
