Enrich cultural experience- This will be measured by the number of students enrolled and participating in this curriculum as well as through connections with Sarasota's sister city of Tel Mond. Improve agricultural production/promotion/education- This will be measured by the number of students enrolled and participating in this curriculum. Improve quality of education- This will be measured by the number of students enrolled and participating in this curriculum.
