c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Economic driver and job creation associated with rental and special events space to accommodate up to 500 participants (ie. catering, event set-up and planning) and facilities to expand youth agricultural education programs beyond the border of Putnam County. Also, the ability to establish distribution center for residents to receive food, water and other life safety essentials during periods of disasters.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Approximately 72,000 and 150,000 residents from Putnam, Flagler and St. Johns Counties.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Multi-use facility will provide direct benefit related to annual fair, 4H and other youth programs, rental/meeting space and have the ability to establish distribution center for residents to receive food, water and other life safety essentials during periods of disasters. Track numbers associated with fair attendance, youth programs and residents served during state of emergencies.
