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11. **Program Performance**

	a. what specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?
	The goal of the project is to reduce recidivism among 500 ex-offenders (male and female), who were released from the Florida Department of Corrections within 1 day- 3 years during fiscal year 2020-2021, and returning to or residing in Orange, Lake and Sumter counties. The project will provide employment training and placement, and educational/technical training, and referrals medical and other social services. Additionally, this project will provide capacity building training to four re-entry organizations in Dade, Duval, Pinellas, Leon and Volusia counties
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	Simeon will offer comprehensive services to 500 participating ex-offenders. The services will include employment training and placement, and comprehensive case management for medical and mental health, housing, technical and educational training and other social services. Additionally, three job fairs will be organized by the employment specialist consultant who will identify and recruit employers that will hire on the spot at each of the job fairs
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Direct services include: assessments, employment, training and placement, education and technical training, medical, social services and housing referrals.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	500 ex-offenders (male and female), who were released from Florida Department of Corrections within 1 day- 3 years during fiscal year 2020-2021, and residing in specific counties.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	This project will divert 500 ex-offenders from re-entering the criminal justice system and will save Floridians over \$10 million dollars through this initiative. Methodology measurements include but not limited to pre/post assessments, interviews, documented services and evaluation.
