4. **Project/Program Description**

SR 907/63rd Street is the northern terminus of SR 907/Alton Road, the second most continuous north-south roadway within the limits of the City of Miami Beach ("City"). This corridor plays a crucial role in the City's transportation network, moving tens of thousands of people on a daily basis. 63rd Street is a congestion point in the Miami Beach transportation network. The proposed enhancement of 63rd Street will include bicycle lanes, bicycle boxes, space for transit, improved traffic flow, enhanced sidewalks, a new connection to the beach and Allison Park, and a designated freight loading area. This enhancement will benefit all users including pedestrians, bicyclists, motorists, and transit riders of all ages and abilities. Complete Streets will offer a safe mobility environment for all users.
