	Assist the Department of Education in its goal to facilitate full inclusion of children with intellectual and developmental disabilities in			
	the school community. This has the additional benefit of creating life long acceptance of individuals with intellectual and			

	developmental disabilities, increasing social skills and self-confidence of students with intellectual disabilities, reducing harmful behaviors such as bullying, and ensuring that future generations of leaders will value inclusion.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	Four major activities: 1. Unified Sports allows children and youth with and without disabilities to be teammates in athletic competitions, some formally sanctioned by the FHSAA; 2. Inclusive Leadership activities; 3. Whole-school engagement activities to promote inclusion to the entire school community; and 4. Young Athletes which serves pre-school children.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Four major activities: 1. Unified Sports allows children and youth with and without disabilities to be teammates in athletic competitions, some formally sanctioned by the FHSAA; 2. Inclusive Leadership activities; 3. Whole-school engagement activities to promote inclusion to the entire school community; and 4. Young Athletes which serves pre-school children.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	Students with intellectual and developmental disabilities as well as K-12 and college students statewide. Approximately 55,000 additional individuals are expected to be impacted through future expansion.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	Promote inclusion of students with intellectual and developmental disabilities in schools and improve attitudes of students without disabilities toward their peers with disabilities. In addition, improved physical and mental health for students with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Special Olympics plans to conduct a number of student/faculty/staff surveys to measure results.
