	This request will fund the initial development of the Women's Health initiative via program development and tuition assistance across
	the programs of Nursing (MS), Family Nurse Practitioner (MS), Women's Health (MS), and the Doctor of Nurse Practitioner (DNP).

The special focus on Women's Health in the master's programs will be through specialized coursework, while the opportunities in the DNP program will emphasize research in the Action Research course, a final requirement of the program.

b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?			
	Education and training of students that will become Advanced Practice Nurses and Doctoral Nurse Practitioners and their training will be critical in providing effective care in the areas of women's health including obstetrics and gynecology, mental health, infant mortality, and gerontological issues			
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?			
	The impact of such an initiative can lead to bringing down infant and maternal mortality and provide specialization training for more advanced practice nurses that are focused on women's specific care needs through generations.

	University students in advanced practice nursing programs seeking a women's health specialty. Up to 40 students will be recruited specifically to take coursework with a womens health specialty. (8-10 students over 4 degree programs).
