	The purpose of disproportionate share hospital funds are to offset the high volumes of under and uninsured patients treated at safety net hospitals. Sacred Heart is the 10th largest Medicaid provider in the state and provides more than twice the amount of charity care in the region than any other hospital. These funds will enable Sacred Heart to continue its mission to serve the poor and vulnerable.
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
	Sacred Heart will continue to treat uninsured patients and Medicaid patients through all sites of care as well as through population health programs, health fairs and in schools and businesses.
c.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Health care services will be provided.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served? Uninsured and Medicaid patients.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	In a local ED Diversion program, Sacred Heart partners with another hospital and the FQHC to address the social determinants of health that cause residents to frequent the emergency room for care. Through relationship building and population health strategies, the program has resulted in lower visits to the emergency rooms and an improved quality of health.
