The proposed improvements will provide improved access to clean water and fire protection that will assist in the growth of Gretna near the interstate. The project has already been designed, and permitted.

The proposed improvements will provide improved access to clean water and fire protection. By installing this ground storage tank, citizens will have access to a larger water supply, especially in emergency situations.

- c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

By installing this ground storage tank, citizens will have access to a clean water supply and fire protection, especially in emergency situations. Increased flows and pressures will be available to accommodate current and future water users in the area.

- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population to be served is all the residents of the City of Gretna, which is nearly 1,700 people. The City also provides water and wastewater services to Gadsden Correctional Institution which adds an additional 1200 people/inmates to the population served.

- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome of this project would be to provide the City of Gretna with an ability to grow towards the Gretna/I-10 interchange by providing water access. An increase of flows and pressures will be available to current and future water users in the area. System flows and pressures can be measured with commonly available measuring equipment (i.e. gauges).
