	The target population to be served is all the residents of the City of Gretna, which is nearly 1,700 people. The City also provides water and wastewater services to Gadsden Correctional Institution which adds an additional 1200 people/inmates to the population served.

	The expected outcome of this project would be to provide the City of Gretna with an ability to grow towards the Gretna/l-10 interchange by providing water access. An increase of flows and pressures will be available to current and future water users in the area. System flows and pressures can be measured with commonly available measuring equipment (i.e. gauges).
