With the proposed improvements, the City will not only mitigate the current supply capacity shortfall, but also have sufficient capacity to carry the City as many as 20 years into the future. The project will supply water to 700 customers on the City's system. The new SCADA system will allow much more capabilities and reliability than the antiquated system the City currently relice on

	It is estimated to serve over 700 connections currently on the City of Bristol's water system, roughly 2,000 citizens.

	The project will supply water to over 700 connections currently on the City's system and will be designed to handle any future growth on the City's water system.
