4. **Project/Program Description**

The purpose of this funding is to preserve the historic Jackson House in downtown Tampa. The Jackson House is a 1905 building that has both historic and cultural significance as one of few remaining resources of the Jim Crow era during which African Americans were not allowed to be guests in hotels and rooming houses patronized by white customers. Its patrons included notable African-American musicians Duke Ellington, Ella Fitzgerald, and Cab Calloway. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., also visited the property. Jackson House has been deteriorating rapidly over the past decade, and this restoration is critical to its survival. It is on the U.S. National Register of Historic Places.

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11. Program Performance

- a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

These funds will be used to preserve a significant historic asset within the City of Tampa, which will serve as a reminder to future generations of the impact of the Jim Crow era on Tampa's residents and visitors.

- b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

A historically appropriate and comprehensive engineering, planning, and construction program to preserve one of the last remaining opportunities to share with members of the community to be passed on for decades. These funds will be spent on construction only.

- c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

While what specific programmatic services haven't yet been determined, the Jackson House Foundation is currently evaluating a variety of uses which are expected to include: community and educational partnership tours, revenue supporting event space, and museum space preserving Tampa's rich history.

- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

A target population of 20,000 visitors to downtown Tampa (the Tampa History Center currently supports over 100,000 visitors annually) including residents, students, and tourists.

- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Exposure to a historic and culturally-significant resource with an opportunity to learn about the African-American history of Tampa measured by number of visitors, reinvigoration of a historic African-American business district that includes recently-renovated Perry Harvey Sr. Park, and a historic black church that is currently under renovation.

- f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

Standard penalties are adequate.
