	proper analytic software technology that not only provides visibility well beyond the eyes and ears of police officers, but also adds
	real-time insights on the nature of activities being observed.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The Department's vision is to become the premier law enforcement agency in Florida, striving to attain the highest level of safety of our community. Citizens rely on law enforcement to protect and serve the community. Having a Real-Time Crime Center will allow the Department to direct personnel and resources to crimes in progress, areas of increased crime, as well as, high populated public events.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The general public. According to the U.S. Census 2018 estimate, the Cape Coral's population is 189,343.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

With access to video camera feeds throughout the City, the Department will be able to enhance their investigations through the utilization of technology, increasing arrests, case closures, and preventing potential acts of violence.

Measuring activities include: investigative results obtained as a result of the technology; arrests made as a result of the technology; acts of violence disrupted as a result of the technology.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?
