4. **Project/Program Description**

In consideration for the safety of local residents and due to the level of deterioration to the existing conditions of the roadway segment along NW 89 th Ave from 95th St. to the FEC Railroad Right-of-Way (ROW), the town is requesting funding for the construction of about 1,200 LF of roadway and drainage improvements. These improvements will include reconstruction of the roadway segment with the creation of a pedestrian-bike share path, sidewalks, roadway striping and landscaping as well as drainage improvements for water quality improvements and flood protection. This project will also have a public involvement component, continuing the town's efforts to interact with and keep the local residents informed on the town's projects.

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11. Program Performance

- a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The project consists of roadway improvements of widening, reconstruction, and milling and resurfacing of about 1,200 LF of a new 3-lane roadway along NW 89th Ave. The work also includes construction of drainage improvements by installing stormwater infrastructure for water quality improvements and flood control.

- b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction services consisting of reconstruction of the roadway, milling, resurfacing, and widening of the existing pavement to accommodate curb and gutter, signage, pavement markings, as well as pedestrian sidewalks and bicycle lane. The project will also include drainage improvements including additional catch basins, swales, and exfiltration trenches with baffled control structures for water quality improvements.

- c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The direct services to the residents of this project are to improve transportation and mobility by providing pedestrian sidewalks and bicycle lanes and improved water quality and drainage. This project will improve roadway conditions and also improve water quality and storage for storm water run-off by installing catch basins, drainage piping, and grading swales.

- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is local residents, business, commercial and industrial, as well as other users as this project will provide improved traffic conditions and water quality. This is anticipated to be about 20,000 people.

- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefits of this project include improving the capacity for a corridor serving a heavy industrial area of the town, promoting growth, economic development, and job creation. The methodology for this project includes structural as well as non-structural components to provide a comprehensive project. This project will also have a public involvement component, continuing the town's efforts to interact with and inform the local residents on the project goals.

Standard contract penalties are sufficient.
