1. **Project Title** Seminole County Government - Discounted Bear-Resistant Refuse Container

3. Date of Request 10/21/2019

4. **Project/Program Description**

In 2015, Seminole County executed the State's first local bear management ordinance, identifying an Urban Bear Management Area (UBMA) and setting forth specific restrictions to reduce the potential for human-bear conflicts. Among those restrictions is the requirement for residents to use bear-resistant containers when placing waste outdoors overnight. As a result of the 2015 ordinance, more than 5,800 bear-resistant containers have been distributed to County residents within the UBMA. FWC has reported that the total number of bear-related reports from within the UMBA have reduced by 42%. This request will allow Seminole County to purchase an additional 3,125 certified bear-resistant refuse containers and sell them to residents at a discounted rate (\$125.73 individual purchase). Additional funds will support Seminole County's goal of increased use of bear-resistant containers among 24,000 residential units within the county's Urban Bear Management Area.

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11. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The primary goal of this program is the reduction of reported human-bear conflicts and injuries, ultimately resulting in a decrease in bear relocation and euthanization.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Seminole County Government will provide bear-resistant refuse containers at a discounted rate to residents of the Urban Bear Management Area (UMBA).

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Seminole County Government will provide bear-resistant refuse containers at a discounted rated to residents of the Urban Bear Management Area (UMBA).

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Residents of Seminole County's Urban Bear Management Area are the project's population targets (approximately 24,000). This appropriation will allow Seminole County to distribute more than 3,000 bear-resistant refuse containers to residents in this area at a reduced cost.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Outcomes include a reduction of human-bear interactions and conflicts within the UMBA, ultimately decreasing the number of bear euthanizations. Since implementation of this program in 2015, more than 5,800 bear-resistant containers have been distributed to County residents within the UBMA. Additionally, during the time the UBMA has been in place, FWC has reported the following: • Reports related to bears-in-garbage have decreased by 58%;

Reports related to bear-animal encounters have decreased by 59%;

- Total number of bear-related reports from within Seminole County's Urban Bear Management Area have reduced 42%.
