a.	What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?
	Centennial Park is an 11-acre park located in historic downtown Fort Myers on the scenic banks of the Caloosahatchee River, hostin

Funds would add amenities including landscaping, ADA compliant pathways, pavilions, and outdoor programmable spaces.
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Funding would provide refurbishment of restrooms, ADA compliant playground equipment and pathways, landscaping, pavilions, and outdoor programmable space connected with the new downtown amphitheater as a part of the downtown Fort Myers Luminary Hotel and Convention Center.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	Developmentally and physically disabled individuals with unique abilities in addition to all citizens who live, work, and visit the City of Fort Myers. More than 250,000 citizens annually are served by the park and that number is expected to increase as the area's population increases.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	Provide access to green spaces and shared community play spaces for fitness, health, and general well being and access to ADA compliant playground equipment and park pathways. Increase the number of special events held in the park for citizens and visitors to enjoy. Outcome can be measured by the increase in the number of special events and attendees to those events, the increase in number of fitness-based events and programming, and the increase in number of children with unique abilities visiting Centennial Park.
f.	What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?
	Forfeiture of funds back to the state.
