a.	What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?				
	Provide operational funding to produce the largest Special Olympics USA Games in history. The 2022 Special Olympics USA Games is also the largest humanitarian event in Florida's history. The 2022 Games will position Florida as a leader in the "inclusion movement," showcase Florida as a disability friendly destination, deliver a projected economic benefit of \$69+ million to Florida, and provide individuals with intellectual disabilities thousands of healthcare screenings and physician referrals at the event.				
b.	What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?				
	FY 2020-21 funds will be used primarily for foundational work (e.g. planning, marketing, private fundraising, logistics) required to execute an event of this magnitude which is expected to bring over 4,000 athletes from across the United States and the Bahamas, as well as attract 125,000 spectators.				
C.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?				
	Direct services that will be provided at the games include free healthcare screenings and referrals provided by healthcare professionals, workshops conducted by international thought leaders to further the goal of community inclusion for individuals with intellectual disabilities, and organization and promotion of the largest humanitarian event in the history of Florida. The games are nationally televised and will produce an estimated \$69 million economic impact.				
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?				
	Individuals with intellectual disabilities and their families are served at the 2022 USA Games. All Floridians benefit as the games will promote Florida as a disability friendly destination committed to inclusion. Additionally, Floridians will benefit from the projected \$69 million in economic impact.				
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?				
	- Improve Physical Health: Health screenings for individuals with intellectual disabilities and referral of the estimated 40% who will require subsequent medical attention in one or more areas. Healthcare professionals administer the screenings and direct athletes to physicians and specialists. The referrals are quantified and tracked and physician visits confirmed. Data is entered into the Special Olympics Healthy Athlete Software (HAS) system which captures screening and referral data Improve Mental Health: The Special Olympics Strong Minds (emotional well-being) program is provided to athletes. This system tracks the number of participants Improve/Increase economic activity and tourism: 67,000 total hotel room nights and a direct economic impact projected by the Central Florida Sports Commission of \$69+ million. Special Olympics will track participation data and will work with the Central Florida Sports Commission to validate projected economic impact.
