	Workforce curriculum, aligned assessments, and earned certificates; job profiler training; and consulting support for creating a workforce-ready ecosystem.
c.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
	Workforce curriculum, aligned assessments, and earned National Career Readiness Certificates.
d.	Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
	Unemployed and under-employed Floridians; individuals looking to increase or diversify their employability skills; and employers struggling to find skilled labor.
e.	What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
	Increased employment (local and state labor data); increased economic self-sufficiency/individual earnings (correlations between workforce assessment levels and WIOA performance data); lower dependence on state and federal financial assistance programs (benefits claimant data from DCF, DEO); faster recruitment and longer retention of employees by employers (surveys of employers); lower recidivism rates for individuals in the justice system (recidivism data from FDC); increase responsiveness of site selection consultants/investors to certified counties as workforce-ready ecosystem (survey, better than 82% national average).
