Improve quality of education: 55 homeless women/female youth will receive one on one education support counseling and assistance in applying for education completion and/or training; 15 homeless women/female youth will begin or complete high school diploma/GED and/or other vocational training; 85 homeless women/female youth will have access to computers and instruction in computers when needed (Summary of service spreadsheet.

Create specific immediate job opportunities: 15 homeless women/female youth will receive paid/unpaid employment internships; 37 homeless women/female youth will obtain employment or increase employment income by program exit.

Enhance specific individual's economic self sufficiency: 37 homeless women/female youth will participate in a job readiness training course; 37 homeless women/female youth will complete a professional resume;
