a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The requested funds will be used to restore capacity to the St. Pete Beach wastewater collection system, which will minimize future sanitary sewer overflows and immediately facilitate commercial development and redevelopment projects.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will be applied to the construction of new sanitary sewer force main and lift stations in the City's most densely populated and heavily trafficked beach-front hotel district providing capacity for development and re-development.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Without this project, the City will remain under a development and redevelopment moratorium.

The project supports the City's tax base by facilitating economic development. It also improves public health a

The project supports the City's tax base by facilitating economic development. It also improves public health and safety by minimizing the potential sanitary sewer overflows.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The City's full-time residential population of approximately 10,000 stands to benefit from the economic development and public health and safety improvements cited above.

The City's extensive tourism industry will benefit from the various development and re-development initiatives that will commence upon restoration of the wastewater collection system capacity.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The success of this project can be measured by change in the number of development and redevelopment projects permitted, and the elimination of sewer overflow and creation of capacity to enable new development and redevelopment to move forward.
