12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Improved health benefits will result from the expansion of service hours and availability. The OB/GYN provider will utilize the services of the perinatologist who will assist with the early identification and treatment of conditions which result in fetal infant deaths and poor birth outcomes such as low birth weight. Also impacting negative birth outcomes is the incident of neonatal abstinence syndrome and the special risks involved with this population.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Comprehensive Maternal Fetal Medicine services for patients referred by MCR Health obstetrical providers. Services include perinatologist, ultrasound technician, care coordination, and support staff.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Medical services, care coordination, and ultrasounds.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Low income uninsured and under-insured in Manatee County.

It is anticipated 450 pregnant women will have at lest one ultrasound and one follow-up visit with the perinatologist and/or perinatologist consult with the obstetrician.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?



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The cost effectiveness and overall goals of the project will be measured by the outcomes data within the target population.

Through analysis of the outcomes data, and improved health status will be realized with the perinatologist involvement in the care of the woman and fetus through better management of the pregnancy. The data collected will be entered into the computer system.

Reports are generated monthly to address the progress made on the outcome measures.
