12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The design and construction of the Wekiwa Springs Septic Sewer Retrofit Project Phase 2 will include a new sanitary sewer collection system that will replace existing on-site septic tank systems within the Wekiwa Springs area. The new facilities will ultimately serve 154 properties within this phase.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Design and construction of a new sanitary sewer collection system, replacement of 154 septic systems.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Design and construction of a new sanitary sewer collection system that will serve 154 properties into the future, removal/abandonment of septic systems on those properties.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

At current household sizes, the 154 properties being sewered would have a population of around 400 persons. However, the regional population will indirectly benefit from improved water quality at Wekiwa Springs through protection of tourism and business value that the springs draw to the area and improved quality of life.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Once constructed, the completed project is estimated to reduce the amount of nutrients introduced into the groundwater in the Wekiwa Springshed by 1,519 pounds of nitrogen per year. Improving the condition of the Spring should also tourism value.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Failure to achieve 67% commitment by community to support MSBU by December 2021 may result in withdrawal of funding.

13. The owners of the facility to receive, directly or indirectly, any fixed capital outlay funding. Include the relationship between the owners of the facility and the entity.

Orange County Board of County Commissioners is the owner of the facility to be constructed, and are the same as the entity receiving funds for design and construction.
