12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To provide critical infrastructure for future residential sewer service to support a reduction in human exposure to bacteria and viral contamination from septic system hydraulic failures resulting in back ups in homes and exposure to sewage contaminated floodwaters that pond in lawns and roadways during and following rain and tidal events.

Economic impacts result from these events, which impacts the livelihood of this community.

The project will also reduce contribution of nutrients and bacteria to surface waters and storm water drainage, resulting in reduced loading in canals and ultimately Biscayne Bay.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The installation of sanitary sewer systems in an area impacted by rising groundwater.

Specifically, a new pump station will be designed and constructed to provide for expansion of the sewer system to serve the area south of Little River and north of 79 Street, between North Miami Avenue and I-95.

The upgrade of the receiving pump station and provision of other associated infrastructure are included in this project.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Wastewater services.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will directly impact a low to middle income community within the unincorporated Miami-Dade County area within the Little River Adaptation Action Area.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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Increased wastewater service capacity to serve the defined project area.

The number of gallons per day that can be managed by the pump station and number of parcels it can serve.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Failure to meet deliverables will jeopardize future funding years/requests.
