The objective of this project is to reduce roadway flooding resulting from king tide and storm surge events associated to sea level rise.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Re-design and re-construction of the roadway cross section to raise the elevation of the road to provide flood protection to residents from king tide and storm surge events .

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This project will reduce flooding and provide roadway access to public and private residents during king tide and storm surge events.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by the project are the residents abutting the roadway. Approximately 300 individuals are expected to be served by this project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit of raising the roadway is that it ensures that flooding resulting from sea level rise king tide and storm surge events will be minimized. Additionally, it will extend the roadway service life.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Liquidating damages will be applied to the contracting agency resulting from failing to meet contract performance measures.
