a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of the requested funds is to provide proper flood mitigation, which is essential to community health and the safety of people and property. This project will build on the Phase 1 improvements to better protect the Aquatic Gardens community, which contains primarily workforce housing.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Improve the culvert capacity at Cutlass Drive. Improve the capacity of the Hopkins Creek ditch via rehabilitation and widening.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Protection of homes and property from flooding after heavy rainfall and tropical events.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Approximately 1,500 residents who live in the Aquatic Gardens community. In addition, the greater population of Atlantic Beach will benefit as local roadways will flood less often with proper flood mitigation.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Reduced incidences of flooding of homes, property and roadways when compared to historical data.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Penalty- Money per day due to not meeting the minimum requirements as provided.
