### 12. Program Performance

### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Through extensive research from University of Miami, it has been proven that bunker gear contains cancer causing contaminates after a fire and there is a risk of cross contamination. This potential exposure has been identified to have serious health risks to our firefighters. This project will provide the needed set of bunker gear to help protect out firefighter from this cross contamination and exposure to cancer.

### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funds will be used to provide 400 complete bunker gear sets for Palm Beach County fire fighters in an effort to reduce exposure to cancer causing agents.

### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

One firefighter's illness or death causes a rippling affect to our community which not only impacts the firefighter, their family, the department and community as a whole. When fire department staff are provided with protective equipment, this reduces the incidents of illnesses and disease, allowing them to be available to provide services to the citizens in need. This provision will also assist in increasing the interest of this career choice for young people in our community.

### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

At-risk firefighters and staff that respond to fire related calls throughout Palm Beach County. According to a 2018 census report, the county had a population of 1,485,941, making it the third-most populous county in the state of Florida and the 25th-most populous county in the United States. The total population is counted because the Palm Beach County Fire Rescue is responsible for providing all municipalities within the County support for any given emergency.

### e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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Decreased incidents of exposure to carcinogens by firefighters and staff that will ultimately cause cancer related illnesses and diseases. Because we have access to the use of the staff at the Palm Beach County Health Department, if approved by the Fire Department Administrator and PBC Commissioners and staff volunteers, a before and after study of health related illnesses could be completed to determine if this additional equipment has helped our rates of loss time due to illness compared to before we received the additional equipment. Because the Univ of Miami has done studies, a partnership could be formed to assist in their research classes and to justify the expense for our future budgets.
