The project will provide a safe structure for housing inmates and the 911 operations of the county.

The building was not safe for our inmates, nor our Sheriff's Office personnel, during Hurricane Michael.

I am attaching a statement from the Sheriff and the 911 Coordinator who were in the building during Hurricane Michael.

The building continues to leak and the structure continues to deteriorate.

Our Fiscally Constrained County has not had the funding necessary to replace the jail structure.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Public safety will be enhanced for the county for both law-abiding and law-breaking individuals.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Enhanced emergency dispatch services, including a safe place for the dispatchers to initiate emergency services. Also, a safe structure for housing the individuals who have violated the law. This keeps them safely incarcerated.

The entire population of Calhoun County and surrounding areas. At a minimum, 14,625 citizens.
