a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The specific purpose of this project is to upgrade an antiquated control system at the Water Works Facility and install "Smart" meters throughout the City. Currently, the City's control system continuously experience failures which results in water shortages throughout the system. Not only at times the citizens do not have water, but the availability for fire protection is shut down, which poses a safety issue. As far as the water meters, many of the meters throughout the City are antiquated and leak. The City has already purchased the software to run a "Smart" meter system. They are seeking funding for the meters to complete the system overhaul. The new meters will eliminate water loss and provide a more efficient and cost saving method of collecting data.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

An upgraded control system at the Water Works Facility and installation of 1400 "Smart" meters will be accomplished through the requested funds.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The appropriation of this project will provide the citizens of Chattahoochee with a reliable water source as well as a more efficient method of collecting meter data.
