Remediate defects that have been detected via inspection of the culvert, to facilitate continued safe use of the culvert and the road that crosses the culvert.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Engineering analysis and design, and contracted construction to significantly rehabilitate or replace (depending on the results of the engineering analysis) a 15 foot by 146 foot steel culvert that allows the C-11 South canal to cross under SW 49 Street in Cooper City.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Maintain the usability and safety of a collector road where it crosses a South Florida Water Management District canal in Cooper City.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This road is estimated to be used by approximately 1,000 motorists per day.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit of this project is the renewal of the subject canal culvert and associated road crossing to extend the useful life of both pieces of infrastructure. This outcome will be measured by routine inspections of the culvert and road to determine its status and functionality.
