Part of the annexation discussion was the City would take over the existing utilities. Current all 105 homes in the annexation area have septic systems. Most of their systems are failing and causing surface water contamination to nearby streams and wetlands. The City plans to build a low pressure sewer system in this subdivision to serve the residents.

##### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of this program to to replace failing septic systems located in an older residential subdivision. Current all 105 homes in the annexation area have septic systems. Most of there systems are failing and causing surface water contamination to nearby streams and wetlands.

Once the new forcemain and pumps are installed the city will maintain the sewer system. This is eliminate all failures due to existing septic tanks.

##### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

A sanitary and function method of sewage disposal. Environmentally safer and more pleasant smelling neighborhood. Current all 105 homes in the annexation area have septic systems. Most of there systems are failing and causing surface water contamination to nearby streams and wetlands. Better and cleaner creeks and waterways.

The Foxwood Estates subdivision includes 105 homes. Current all 105 homes in the annexation area have septic systems. Most of there systems are failing and causing surface water contamination to nearby streams and wetlands.

##### e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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Currently there is measurable E.Coli and Fecal Coliform in the drainage ditches within the road right-of-way. Currently there is obvious seepage with the septic drain fields leeching to the roadway. Once the new sewer system is installed we will do a visual inspection and retest the runoff to insure the system has improved the water's health.

The City will enforce liquidated damages on any and all contractors who fail to meet required time lines.
