a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project will provide drainage structural improvements and wetland mitigation to reduce flooding of Baum Road and associated stream erosion.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The drainage structural improvements will reduce the increased water flow generated by uphill development (north of Winfield Forest subdivision), which overwhelms the Baum Road cross-drain during heavy storms.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Functional, safe, and effective stormwater systems are beneficial to all citizens of Leon County and its visitors, and are essential to conserving valuable economic, natural, and other resources.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All residents of Leon County will benefit from this project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The improved drainage system will enhance conveyance capacities to minimize flooding and reduce stream erosion. The benefits of the project include improved water quality and rate control, prevention of personal injury and private property loss, and loss to Leon County associated with stormwater runoff. The outcomes of the project can be measured by the reduction of flooding during heavy storms.
