a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The rehabilitation of the Leon County Historic Amtrak Station will support the adaptive reuse of the property to serve as a vibrant centerpiece of the community that connects both residents and visitors alike to the area's history and heritage.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The restored Historic Amtrak Station will provide a public venue for local events and arts and history exhibits as well as government and community activities. The new Tallahassee-Leon County Visitor Information Center at the Leon County Historic Amtrak Station will generate significant visitation as the starting point for many local/regional touring activities. The site will include a historical display to educate the public on the significance of the building, its builders, the cultural history of the period and area, and the railroad station's role in the development of Tallahassee and Florida's capital region.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

As the hub for "Visit Tallahassee" Welcome Center, the restored building will be the future home of the visitor information center and tourism offices for Florida's Capital Region. In addition, the restored building will provide event space for community gatherings, a community theater, and exhibits that showcase local history and heritage.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will benefit all residents of Leon County, as well as the 2.4 million visitors traveling to Leon County annually.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?



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This project will serve as an important community resource that better connects residents and visitors to Leon County's history and heritage, which can be measured by foot-traffic levels at the Visitor Information Center and tourism offices, number of various events hosted at the community gathering room, ticket sales, and activities at the cinema.
