a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

With the funds requested the City will be able to begin Phase I construction of a sewer system to reduce the amount of pollutants discharged into the groundwater system through collection of all wastewater through the sewer system. Additionally, wastewater will be managed by a Public Utility instead of discharged into drain fields on small lots within a densely populated area and a reduction of pollution into groundwater by a sewer system collection of wastewater instead of septic systems, which the City has no control over maintenance, will be achieved. Reduction of pollutants leading into the LWDD Canal E-3, LWDD Canal L-11 and LWDD Canal L-10.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Services to provide a sanitary sewer system to the residents of the City.

Services to provide a sanitary sewer system to the residents of the City.
