The project will provide water services and correct poor water quality, low pressure and water loss within the system for target populations in Census Tracts 412 (West Ken Lark) and Census Tracts 413 (Broward Estates).

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The installation of infrastructure is needed to provide water service.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct water service will be provided to residents that are not currently serviced by the City.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The targeted population is located within Census tracts 412 (West Ken Lark) and tract 413 (Broward Estates) consisting of over 13,260 low-income residents of which 21 percent are Seniors age 60 and over (per Census Table DP-05)

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit is increased water supply and service. The outcome measure of the project is increased resident satisfaction of water demands being met. The methodology used are pre and post resident surveys to calculate the level of satisfaction with the water supply and service.
