4. Project/Program Description

Riverside Drive provides connectivity to over 40,000 people in Broward County and beyond. Connects over 4,000 local residents. The road serves residential, commercial, and low industrial facilities. The road carries 11,000 trips, all within a local residential area connecting NE 14th Street and Atlantic Boulevard. The roadway provides the only other alternative to A1A as an evacuation route within its boundaries. There are insufficient sidewalks to provide a safe passage for children and residents. Street lighting is lacking and the public has voiced their concerns for safety. There is severe ponding conditions along the corridor and the roadway is prone to flooding. Sea level rise impacts are being addressed as part of the design.

Construction of streetscape improvements on the corridor. Address sea level rise impacts. Improve pedestrian connectivity. Realign roadway and provide for safer travel lanes.

Complete design and construction. Improve pedestrian and traffic accessibility from Atlantic Boulevard to NE 14th Street.

Improve vehicular driving experience. Add missing sidewalks and on-street parking. Provide traffic controls and realign roadway. Improve roadway system in support of residential traffic serving over 6,000 people. Improve drainage to address future impacts due to sea level rise.

Over 800 (students from elementary to high school, merchants, residents of all ages).

The redesigned roadway will improve pedestrian connectivity, improve drainage, add street lighting, and add landscaping. Items will be measured using local area planning reporting standards.
