b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The matching funds will go to replace an exisiting brige that does not allow for appropriate access for pedestrians and other means of multimodal transportation. The exisiting bridge is old, does not accomodate for the handicapped and is difficult to navigate based on current hight and width. The new bridge will be 20' wide with longer landings and easier managable slopes.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct access for elementary kids to safely bike or walk to Windermere Elementary. Connects civic, commercial, educational, and recreational trail systems.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Elementary school children, elderly, physically disabled people, and the general population.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This is the only access over the canal for elementary kids to get to Windermere Elementary School without going onto a traffic congested roadway. Keep not only kids, but pedestrians, bikers, etc., off the roads and onto a safe bridge to travel.
