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This project involves the development of a facility that will include a cultural center, community center, gymnasium, football/soccer fields, parking areas, and a community pool. The three-story building will accommodate cultural events and programming, while the athletic facilities will be able to host large scale and day-to-day competitions and recreation events. Special needs programming will be of specific concern to make the facility entirely ADA accessible. According to the Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development (ASCD), risk factors can lead to the detriment of a student's capacity to envision or achieve success. This multipurpose center will be a benefit to the community and surrounding cities.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Once the city selects a vendor to perform the scope of services, a series of meetings will occur to establish time line, objectives, etc. If the selected vendor does not meet the given objectives, the city would then issue a warning, if the penalties continue to the city will then liquidate the damage and start the performance bond process.
