Expansion of the current Eugene Lamb, Jr., Recreation Center to address a critical need for creating a City of Midway facility for COVID supports, emergency sheltering, and other special needs of its citizens.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction for expansion of the City of Midway's Eugene Lamb, Jr., Recreation Center.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

COVID and recent emergency disaster demands have highlighted the City of Midway's lack of an emergency preparedness or special needs facility to support its population of approximately 3,500 citizens. The city urgently needs a facility to sufficiently accommodate local citizen supports such as COVID testing, vaccination, emergency sheltering, and other special needs. The City of Midway proposes expansion of its Eugene Lamb, Jr., Recreation Center for this purpose.

Citizens of the City of Midway will receive direct local citizen supports such as COVID testing, COVID vaccination, emergency sheltering, and other special needs.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The City of Midway's general population will be served as funding will allow the city to serve all 3,500 citizens before, during, and after COVID and disasters.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

This project will expand and provide a facility that will serve as an emergency operations center during COVID, disaster situations, and other special needs for the protection and/or provision of critical services to citizens during and after a crisis and result in outcomes of improved physical health and protection of the general public from harm. These outcomes will be measured by the provision of a safe facility to support local citizens needs during COVID, a disaster, or crisis.
